

Make bridge fun again, despite poor eyesight



“What a change! Since starting using the Yellow Eyes playing bridge about 70 percent of the cards land where I can see them. Without Yellow Eyes it was only 5 percent. I take tricks based on my ability not only luck,” says Käte Schierwagen-Stenborg.

The Yellow Eyes have helped bridge players to continue with their hobby although their eyesight has become worse.

Yellow Eyes is a silent reminder to the other players where to lay the cards. In the moment the card is played the Yellow Eye steer it to the right place on the table.

The visually impaired person doesn't have to remind the others and no questions about what cards have been played must be raised.

“The Yellow Eyes and helpful bridge players have made it possible for me to continue with bridge since my vision impaired in 2004. Bridge keeps the brain alert and I cannot think of a better hobby. I will continue to play as long as I can!”

Katarina Stenborg is a member of the Gothenburg Inventors Federation and the Swedish Bridge Federation.

Her invention, the Yellow Eyes, is an aid that will help bridge players to continue to play bridge even if they get affected by macula degeneration or other diseases that make their vision impaired.
